Review and Possible Approval of the March 21st, 2022 General Board Meeting Minutes: After Board members reviewed the March 21st, 2022 General Meeting of the Board Minutes, Director Amundson moved to approve as presented, Director Lalonde seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

<u>Surfside Colony, Ltd. Project Status:</u> K.C. Coultrup, Project Manager, reported that the Street Replacement - Section 6 Project is approximately 50% complete with sewer laterals being installed. Concrete would be starting this week and completion is expected before Memorial Day weekend. A preliminary request for funds for upcoming Street Replacement - Sections 0 and 1, which is expected to commence in the Fall. A formal request would be presented at next month's meeting, per the District's Budget Policy. Director Garofalo inquired regarding the status of Surfside Colony, Ltd.'s Streetlight Project.

Review and Possible Approval of Current Bills Presented: Clerk Montana presented check #'s 3712-3715 for a total amount of \$124,386.25, consisting of \$44,904.25 for the monthly Security and Maintenance billing, \$1,408.00 for general and administrative expenses, and \$78,074.00 for Street Replacement – Section 6 Project Costs. After discussion and review, checks were approved and signed as presented.

<u>Clerk's Report, Fund Balance and Review of Trial Balance:</u> Clerk Montana reported the fund balance as of April 25th, 2022 to be \$624,076 and reviewed the current month's trial balance with the Board. In addition, Clerk Montana distributed an updated 5-year Cash Flow Projection for the Board's review in order to determine financing available for future projects.

The Clerk presented the presented the 3rd Quarter 2021-22 Surfside Colony Ltd. Security and Maintenance Contract Reconciliation for review and discussion. The Clerk explained that any amounts paid by the District in excess of Surfside Colony Ltd.'s actual expenditures per contract allocations would be credited on the final June 2022 invoice. A motion was made and carried to approve the reconciliation as follows:
