<u>Surfside Colony, Ltd. Street Replacement Project – Section 1 Status Update:</u> Clerk Montana distributed the Project Status Template for the Street Replacement Project – Section 1 (attached). Per Surfside Colony Ltd.'s Project Manager K.C. Coultrup, the Project would be completed by the end of the current week. Clerk Montana reported to the Board that due to the District's current cash flow position, Project Cost Reimbursement invoices presented would not be fully paid until the District has received its share of secured property taxes from the County of Orange. Surfside Colony, Ltd. had been informed of the cash flow scheduling at time of Project Approval.

Review and Possible Approval of Current Bills Presented: Clerk Montana presented check #'s 3744-3747 for a total amount of \$66,666, consisting of \$45,541 for the November 2022 Security and Maintenance billing, \$1,125 for general and administrative expenses, and \$20,000 for Project Cost Reimbursement.
